Later in the afternoon we are opening the Centre up to visitors for a sausage sizzle at 5.00pm.

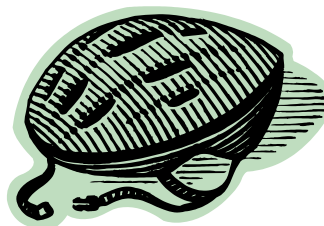
At 5.30pm Miss Crabbe will say goodbye to her hair as we all cheer her on. Everyone is welcome to attend!
